

## 6 Day Pilgrimage to Mexico

Wed, Nov 14<sup>th</sup>: New York -Mexico City

Depart JFK or Newark airport on your morning flight to Mexico City. On arrival you will be met by your guide and transferred to your hotel. Remainder of the day is free.

Thu, Nov 15<sup>th</sup>: Mexico City - Puebla – Cholula -Mexico City

Today we visit Santo Domingo (St. Dominic) Church with its' beautiful Chapel of Our Lady of the Rosary. The Chapel has been called the "Eighth Wonder of the World," because of its ornate scalloped gold leaf walls and ceilings. Next we visit the Church of St. Francis of Assisi to see the incorrupt body of St. Sebastian de Aparicio.

Fri, Nov 16<sup>th</sup>: Mexico City – Ocotlan – Tlaxcala – Mexico City

Morning departure to Ocotlan for Mass at the beautiful Basilica of Our Lady of Ocotlan. After Mass we see the miraculous statue which was found by the local Indians in 1541. The statue was found in a burning tree. It is said that the statue was made in heaven and brought to Tlaxcala. Our Lady told Juan Diego Bernadino "through my image I will give many blessings and favors." She directed him to a nearby well and those who drank from it were cured. We will have the opportunity to drink from this well and obtain some of the miraculous water. Our last visit today is to San Miquel del Milagro where St. Michael the Archangel appeared to Diego Lazaro in 1631. Here we also find another miraculous well.

Sat, Nov 17<sup>th</sup>: Mexico City

After breakfast, we travel along the Plaza of the Three Cultures to see the ancient ruins and visit the baptismal place of Juan Diego. We continue to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the patroness of the Americas. We have

Mass in the brilliantly colored, modern Basilica dedicated in 1976. We join other pilgrims as we kneel before the altar displaying the astounding Tilma, the sackcloth bearing the image of the Holy Virgin. In this holiest of churches in the Western Hemisphere we see pilgrims go down the aisle on their knees in honor of Our Lady. It is an inspiring experience. We will have time to view the Tilma of Juan Diego, which still bears Our Lady's imprint. Those who wish may climb Mt. Tepeyac to the monastery on top.

This afternoon we travel to San Juan Teotihuacan to visit the pyramids of the Sun and Moon and the Temple of Quetzalcoatl.

Sun, Nov 21<sup>st</sup>: Mexico City
