

## 10 Day Pilgrimage to Austria and Germany

visiting Ettal, Oberammergau, Innsbruck, Salzburg,  
Mondsee, Mariazell, Melk, Vienna & Munich

**September 21 – 30, 2009**

Mon, Sept 21<sup>st</sup>: New York/Munich - Depart JFK or Newark Airport on your overnight flight to Munich. Dinner served in flight.

Tue, Sept 22<sup>nd</sup>: Munich/Ettal/Oberammergau - Upon arrival in Munich we are transferred to **Oberrammergau**. En route we stop at **Ettal** to visit Ettal Abbey. The monastery is a masterpiece of rococo architecture. It was originally founded in 1330 by the King of Bavaria Ludwig IV. The abbey is unique in Germany due to its polygonal shape. The architect Enrico Zucalli created the facade and choir at the beginning of the 18th century. Ettal remains a working Benedictine Monastery to this day. The monastery has its own distillery shop. After our visit, we continue to Oberammergau for check in at our hotel. (B,D)

Wed, Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>: Oberammergau - Today we tour the town of Oberammergau, which is best known for the most famous Passion Play in the world. The play, which is enacted every ten years, is an all day performance put on by the people of Oberammergau in thanksgiving for being spared during the great plague. There was a performance in 2000. The next performance will be in 2010. After our tour we are free to explore Oberammergau on our own. Visit the local craft shops and just enjoy a relaxing day in this beautiful Bavarian town. (B,D)

Thu, Sept 24<sup>th</sup>: Oberammergau/Innsbruck/Salzburg - Morning departure to **Salzburg**. En route we stop at **Innsbruck** for a panorama of the city and an opportunity to shop in the old town. After our visit, we continue to Salzburg. Upon arrival we will go to **Maria Plain** for Mass. (B,D)

Fri, Sept 25<sup>th</sup>: Salzburg/Mondsee - Today we will have a Sound of Music Tour. We will visit places associated with the movie including a stop in **Mondsee** for Mass at the Cathedral of Mondsee. It is a day of fun that includes singing some of our favorite songs. (B,D)

Sat, Sept 26<sup>th</sup>: Salzburg/Mariazell - Today we depart to the oldest place of Pilgrimage, to Our Lady, in central Europe, **Mariazell**. The Basilica of Mariazell is one of the most important Christian architectural monuments in Europe. December 21, 1157 is the traditional date of the Church's foundation. The first documented pilgrimage was in 1330. In 1907 the church was raised to the status of Basilica Minor. The funeral of Cardinal Mindszenty of Hungary was held here in 1975. On May 3, 1991 Cardinal Mindszenty's remains were returned to Hungary. The Basilica of Mariazell was visited by Pope John Paul II on September 13, 1983. (B,D)

Sun, Sept 27<sup>th</sup>: Mariazell/Melk Abbey/Vienna/Mariazell - Morning departure to **Vienna**. En route we stop to visit **Melk Abbey**. On a precise overlooking the green meadows beside the Danube stands an abbey and a church, crowned by towers and resplendent in golden ochre. The abbey building itself might well be mistaken for a palace. This is Melk Abbey, one of the most imposing architectural masterpieces north of the Alps and a focal point in the formative years of Austria's history. 1989 was the 900th anniversary of the day on which Melk was given over to Benedictine monks. The site had been the first residence of the Babenberg rulers of Austria, who had held the eastern marches of the Carolingian Empire in fiefdom for over a century. After our visit, we continue to Vienna. Upon arrival we are met by our local guide for a tour of this beautiful city including a visit to Schonbrunn Palace. After our visit, we return to Mariazell for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

Mon, Sept 28<sup>th</sup>: Mariazell - Free day for private devotion. (B,D)

Tue, Sept 29<sup>th</sup>: Mariazell/Munich – Morning departure to Munich. Upon arrival in **Munich** you will have a city tour. During your walk through the ancient city of Munich you will see: the Marienplatz lined by the Old and the New Town hall, the delightful carillon, the Frauenkirche (cathedral), the Old Residence (a former imperial palace) with its Monkey Tower, the Hofbräuhaus, St. Peter's (the oldest church of Munich), the Town Clerk House, the Old Mint, the Platzl alleyways and the Asamkirche, one of the finest Rococo style churches of the world. (B,D)

Wed, Sept 30<sup>th</sup>: Munich/USA - Morning departure to Munich airport for our return flight. (B)
