

11 Day Pilgrimage to Fatima, Nazare, Bathlha, Alcobaca, Braga, Santiago de Compostelo, Oviedo, Lourdes & Madrid

June 15 - 25, 2009

Mon, June 15th: Newark/Lisbon - Depart Newark Airport on your overnight flight to Lisbon. Dinner served in flight.

Tue, June 16th: Lisbon/Fatima - Upon arrival in Lisbon, we are transferred to **Fatima**. En route we stop at **Santarem** to venerate the Eucharistic Miracle. Upon arrival in Fatima, we check into our hotel. After time to rest, we go to **Aljustrel** where we visit the homes of the children and perhaps meet some of their relatives. Next to **Valinhos** where Our Lady appeared to the children in August 1917 and where the Angel appeared to the children in 1916. We end our day at the Parish Church of Fatima. (B,D)

Wed, June 17th: Fatima - Today we visit the Chapel of Apparitions, the Chapel of Adoration and the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary where we see the Tombs of Sister Lucia, Blessed Jacinta and Francisco. Remainder of the day is free for private devotions. (B,D)

Thu, June 18th: Fatima/Nazare/Batalha/Alcobaca/Fatima - After Mass, we depart to the Monastery of **Batalha**. Santa Maria da Vitória was built in answer to a vow made by King John I to the Virgin. Elected by UNESCO as a World Heritage site, it is a grand monument to the closing phase of Portuguese Gothic whose building began in 1388. We continue to The Monastery of **Alcobaca** which can be found in the fertile valley formed by the Alcoa and Baça's rivers. King Afonso Henriques built the monastery to fulfill a vow he made to the Cistercian Order, when he conquered Santarém from the Moors. The building work began in 1178 following the model of the Claraval Abbey, in France. In the lateral chapels of the transept are the tombs of Pedro I and Inês de Castro. Our last stop is **Nazare**. On hot days the ancient local fishing art is brought to life, with the skipper calling the men down to the sea. The men run down the beach and help push the "candil" - a small fishing boat - down to the sea. In the past this was a daily scene on Nazaré beach. Nowadays the fishermen still mend their nets on the beach, tell fishing yarns and prepare their equipment for bait fishing. (B,D)

Fri, June 19th: Fatima/Braga/Santiago de Compostello - Morning departure to **Santiago de Compostello**. En route we stop at Bom Jesus. Castelo do Bom Jesus, is set in woods high above Portugal's city of Braga on the summit of Monte Bom Jesus. After our visit we continue to Santiago de Compostello. Upon arrival, we visit the Basilica where we have Mass. After Mass we have free time to visit the city on our own. (B,D)

Sat, June 20th: Santiago de Compostello - Free day. (B,D)

Sun, June 21st: Santiago de Compostello/ Oviedo - Morning departure to **Oviedo** to visit the Cathedral of Oviedo. The relic which is held in the Camara Santa in the Cathedral of Oviedo is a piece of cloth measuring approximately 84 x 53 cm. There is no image on this cloth. To the naked eye only stains are visible but more is visible under a microscope. The remarkable thing about this cloth is that both tradition and scientific studies claim that the cloth was used to cover and clean the face of Jesus after the crucifixion. The gospel of John records: "Simon Peter, following him, also came up, went into the tomb saw the linen cloth lying on the ground, and also the cloth that had been over his head; this was not with the linen cloth but rolled up in a place by itself." John clearly differentiates between this smaller face cloth, the sudarium, and the larger linen that had wrapped the body. We have free time to walk around this beautiful city before check in at our hotel. (B,D)

Mon, June 22nd: Oviedo/Lourdes - Morning departure to **Lourdes**. Upon arrival, we have a walking tour of the Grotto and the Basilica. In the late afternoon, join the Blessing of the Sick. After dinner, join the **Candlelight Procession**. (B,D)

Tue, June 23rd: Lourdes - Today we have a tour of the town of Lourdes. We visit the house where St. Bernadette was born and the Church where she was baptized. Remainder of the day is free. After dinner join the **Candlelight Procession**. (B,D)

Wed, June 24th: Lourdes/Madrid - Morning departure to **Madrid**. Upon arrival we have a panorama of the city. (B,D)

Thu, June 25th: Madrid/USA - Depart to Madrid airport for your return flight to the USA. (B)
