ITINERARY:

Thu, Oct 7th - New York - Depart on your overnight flight to Tel Aviv. Dinner served in flight.

Fri, Oct 8th - Tel Aviv - Overnight on the Mediterranean Coast - Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport you are met by your local guide and transferred to your hotel on the coast. Dinner and overnight.



Sat, Oct 9th - Caesarea, Mt Carmel, Stella Maris, Carmelites, Cana, Nazareth Mount Carmel - In the Footsteps of Saint Peter and Elijah

We depart via the coast to Caesarea Maritime where St. Peter baptized the first Gentile convert (Cornelius) and where he was held prisoner by the Romans. It was the center of the Roman governors including Pontius Pilate. We visit the Roman and Crusader ruins, the Crusader City, the well preserved Theatre, the Harbor, and the Roman Aqueduct. Heading towards Haifa through the Carmel Mountains, we visit the Carmelite Monastery Stella Maris and Muhraqa located on the spot where Elijah confronted the false priests of Ba'al (1 Kings 18:17-40). Drive to Cana of Galilee where Jesus performed his first miracle at the request of his mother (John 2:1-11). In Cana we visit the Franciscan Chapel for a renewal of Wedding Vows. Continue to the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth where we celebrate Mass and visit Mary's Well. Next to the Church of the Angel Gabriel. We arrive in Tiberias in time for dinner.



Sun, Oct 10th - The Ministry of Christ in Galilee: Tiberias, Boat Ride, Sea of Galilee, Capernaum, Mt. Beatitudes, Jordan River - This morning we begin with a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee. Our stop will be on the shores of Capernaum where Peter lived and where Jesus began his public ministry (Math. 4:13). There Jesus began teaching in its Synagogue, healed a

man who had an unclean spirit and healed a fever in Simon Peter's mother-in-law (Luke 4:31-41). Next, we visit the Mount of Beatitudes to have a panoramic view of the Sea of Galilee and where one of Jesus' famous teachings' "the Sermon on the Mount," was given (Matthew 5-7). Then to Tabgha, the fruitful garden, where Jesus fed five thousand people with five loaves of bread and two fish (Mark 6:30-46). Next we see the magnificent mosaic commemorating the miracle of the multiplication. We continue to the nearby Chapel of St. Peter's Primacy for an unforgettable Mass near the shores of the Sea of Galilee. We proceed to the Jordan River to renew our baptismal vows where Our Lord was baptized by John (Mark 1:9). Dinner and overnight at Galilee.

Mon, Oct 11th - Mt Tabor, Beth Shan, Jericho, Jerusalem - We start the day by going to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration (Math. 17:1-8). We ascend by a smaller motor vehicle due to its narrow route. We celebrate Mass on the summit. We drive on passing the small town of Nain, where Jesus raised the widow's son (Luke. 7:11-17). Next we visit the excavations of the ancient city of Beth Shan. In the New Testament it became one of the 10 Decapolis. Drive through the Jordan Valley and up through the Judean Wilderness pass the town of Jericho to visit Tel Jericho, the most ancient city in the world. We stop at the Sycamore Tree which we believe Zacchaeus had climbed to catch a glimpse of the Savior. We stop to view Mt. Temptation where Jesus spent forty days and forty nights fasting and meditating during the temptation of Satan. We make our way through the Judean Hills towards the house of the Lord. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Jerusalem.



Tue, Oct 12th - Jerusalem and Bethlehem - Church of Visitation, Shepherd's Fields, Church of the Nativity - After breakfast we will head to the hill country, to the city of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St John the Baptist. We visit the Church of the Visitation where the Blessed Virgin Mary visited the home of Zachariah and Elizabeth, and proclaimed the 'Magnificat' (Luke

1:39-80). We visit the Shrine of the Book, the home of Dead Sea scrolls, and Model of Jerusalem during the time of Jesus. In the afternoon we drive to the Shepherd's Fields where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. We visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem. We kneel in the Grotto, the birth place of our Redeemer, and we celebrate Mass. We drive to Jerusalem passing Rachel Tomb en route. Dinner and overnight.



Wed, Oct 13th - Mt Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Dominus Flevit, Gethsemane, Cave of Betrayal, Cave of Assumption, Pater Noster

After breakfast we start our pilgrimage in Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives. We have an eye on history through a majestic view over Jerusalem. We visit the Convent of Pater Noster where the Lords' Prayer is displayed in 110 languages and where Jesus ascended into Heaven (Acts 1:9-11). We walk down the "Palm Sunday" route stopping at Dominus Flevit for Mass where Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41). Next we visit Gethsemane, the Rock of Agony where Jesus prayed His last prayer before His arrest. We visit the cave of betrayal (Luke. 22:40-46). Then to the cave of the Assumption of Mary to Heaven. We drive along the Kedron Valley where you will see the Tombs of Avishalom, Zachariah and the Prophets Tombs. Return to the hotel for dinner.



Thu, Oct 14th - Stations of the Cross, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, St Anne's Church. Ecce Homo, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, Wailing Wall, Upper Room, Dormition - Today is a full day of meditation and inspiration. In the early morning we retrace the last steps of Jesus. As we walk the Fourteen Stations along the Via Dolorosa and say the Stations of

the Cross. We reflect on the greatness of Jesus' sacrifice as He bore the burden of our sins on the Cross at Golgotha. Finally we arrive at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre for Mass. We return back towards St. Stephen Gate to visit St. Anne's Church, the home of the Virgin Mary and her parents Saints Joachim and Anne. We pass the Ecce Homo where Pilate proclaimed "Behold the man"; then to the Wailing Wall, the most holy shrine for Jews. Nearby is the Dome of the Rock or Temple Mount. We exit at Mt Zion. At the Cenacle we visit the Upper Room of the Last Supper and King David Tomb. Next we go to Dormition Abbey where we believe the Blessed Virgin Mary died. We end the day at St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus three times. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Holy Hour in Gethsemane, the group will attend a special Holy Hour service at 8 pm on Thursday night in the Church of All Nations in Gethsemane, commemorating Christ's Agony in the Garden before his betrayal.

Fri, Oct 15th - The Wilderness: Bethany, Wadi Qelt, Dead Sea - We begin our day in Behtany with a visit to the home of Mary and Martha and where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. Next we visit Lazarus' tomb. We may celebrate Mass in the Church of St. Lazarus, the Inn of the Good Samaritan. The desert east of Jerusalem is rich in Christian tradition. Further east, just off the Roman road that Jesus 'walked', is Wadi Qelt, site of the Monastery of St George. We drive to the Dead Sea to visit Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery. Enjoy a swim (or rather a float!) in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea. Free time at leisure in Jerusalem.

Sat, Oct 16th – Departure - Transfer to the airport, filled with cherished memories, for your return flight home.
