On your journey to Cairo you drive through cultivated deserts and modern industrial towns. Your first stop will be the Citadel of Saladin and the Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali. View the fascinating skyline of Old Cairo from the top of the hill. Drive downtown to the banks of the River Nile where a luxurious cruise boat awaits to take you on the same timeless waterway traversed by Pharaohs, Queens and Nobles thousands of years ago. Enjoy a sumptuous buffet lunch in elaborate surroundings as you glide past Cairo's waterfront landmark. After the cruise drive to the Giza Plateau where the only remaining Wonder of the Ancient World, The Great Pyramids of Giza are found. A panoramic view of the three pyramids from the Western Plateau affords great opportunities for photographs. Continue down the valley to visit the guardian of this complex, the mysterious Sphinx. A stop will be made at a Papyrus Institute where the art of paper making from reeds will be demonstrated and there will be time for souvenir shopping.

Fri, Aug 6<sup>th</sup>: Port Said (Egypt) **Optional Excursions will be offered** - From **Port Said** you will enter the fascinating and mysterious Egyptian desert. We pass millennia-old masterpieces that still have the power to amaze. The bus excursions or cruises along the Nile take in the incredible Pyramids of Giza, the Mastaba of Mereruka in Sakkara and the Colossus of Ramses II in Memphis. These tours include a visit to Cairo, the largest metropolis in Africa, and the Egyptian Museum. **We set sail for Ashdod, Israel at 11:00 PM**

Sat, Aug 7<sup>th</sup>: Ashdod (Israel) Arrival at 8:00 AM **Optional Excursions will be offered - Ashdod** is the fifth largest city in Israel, located in the Southern District of the country, on the Mediterranean coast.

This extremely evocative itinerary leaves from the port of Ashdod and takes you through Christianity's most sacred places. The first part of your day will be based in **Jerusalem**. A tour by panoramic bus around the new part of the city will take you to **Gethsemane**, where you will be able to pause to reflect on the evocative **Mount of Olives**. Moving on into the **Old City** you will see the **Wailing Wall**, which attracts Jewish pilgrims from all over the world, and walk along part of **Via Dolorosa (Way of the Cross)**, the same route which Jesus walked to the Calvary beneath the **weight of the cross**. You will then visit the **Holy Sepulchre**, known in ancient times as **Golgotha**, or "Hill of the Skull" because of its rounded shape and the legend that the skull of Adam is buried here. This hill, on which the tomb of Christ is found, concentrates the deepest emotions of every visitor, whatever their religion. The second part of the day will take place in **Bethlehem**. Here you will have the opportunity to visit the celebrated **Church of the Nativity**, built in 332 AD by Constantine the Great, a destination for multitudes of believers from all faiths. You will have time to pray and also to buy a small memento of this holy place. **We set sail for Limassol, Cyprus at 7:00 PM**

Sun, Aug 8<sup>th</sup>: Limassol (Cyprus) Arrival at 8:00 AM **Optional Excursions will be offered - Cyprus** derives its name from the Latin "cuprum" (copper). In fact, mines in the southern part of the island are rich with copper, still extracted today and manufactured in the artistic Cypriot way. **We set sail for Rhodes, Greece at 1:00 PM**

Mon, Aug 9<sup>th</sup>: Rhodes (Greece) Arrival at 7:30 AM **Optional Excursions will be offered - Rhodes** is one of the most important islands in the Mediterranean. According to mythology, the coast is the wedding present left to men by Helios who fell in love with the nymph Rhoda and dedicated the island and its beauty to her. **We set sail for Piraeus (Athens), Greece at 4:00 PM**

Tue, Aug 10<sup>th</sup>: Piraeus/Athens (Greece) Arrival at 8:00 AM **Optional Excursions will be offered -** The cradle of Greek civilization, **Athens** today is a bustling, frenetic, modern city with six million inhabitants, one third of the total population of Greece. Although Athens is a huge, sprawling city, much of its political, historical and administrative life is concentrated in a small area including Syntagma (Constitution) Square, the Acropolis and Omonia Square. The historical attractions of Athens are world-renowned. The Acropolis, overlooking the city of Athens from the top of a rocky hillside, is the dominant monument of ancient Greece, the site of the first temple dedicated to the goddess Athena and the stunning Parthenon. **We set sail for Katakolon (Olympia), Greece at 5:00 PM**

Wed, Aug 11<sup>th</sup>: Katakolon/Olympia (Greece) Arrival at 8:00 AM **Optional Excursions will be offered - Katakolon** is a small port founded in the first half of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and linked to the legendary and nearby Olympia. Olympia, together with Delphi, the city dedicated to Apollo, and Athens represents the most important mythological places in traditional Greece. The Olympic Games originated here. **We set sail for Savona, Italy at 1:00 PM**

Thu, Aug 12<sup>th</sup>: ...cruising... Day at sea

Fri, Aug 13<sup>th</sup>: Savona/Padua - Arrival at 9:00 AM. Upon arrival we are met by our motorcoach and transferred to **Padua**. Upon arrival we visit the Basilica of St. Anthony of Padua for Mass near the Tomb of St. Anthony.

Sat, Aug 14<sup>th</sup>: Padua/Venice/Padua - Upon arrival in **Venice** you will have a Walking Tour of Venice including St. Marks Square, the Clock Tower with its famous Moors and St. Marks Basilica with its Byzantine and European architectural styles and dazzling mosaics. We stop to pray at the tomb of St. Mark before continuing our tour. Next we are transferred by motor launch to Santa Lucia to visit the Church of St. Geremia & St. Lucia to see the body of St. Lucy. **Venice became a World Heritage Site in 1987. We have Mass today at the Church of St. Geremia & St. Lucy near the body of St. Lucy.**
