ITINERARY:

Day 1: Seattle, Washington Depart 4:00PM

Situated on Puget Sound, surrounded by the Olympic and Cascade mountain ranges, the Seattle city skyline is impressive with shimmering glass high-rises and 100-year-old buildings standing side by side. This beautiful port city came into its own after gold was discovered in the Klondike and 100,000 people passed through the Northwest in 1897 and 1898 on their quest for wealth in Alaska.

Day 2: At Sea

Day 3: Juneau, Alaska Arrive 12:00PM Depart 10:00PM

Perched on a thin strip of land at the mouth of Gold Creek, Juneau is arguably one of America's most beautiful state capitals, with the looming summits of Mt. Juneau and Mt. Roberts providing a gorgeous backdrop.

Mendenhall Glacier Explorer

Embark on an excursion offering the most time at Juneau's marquee attraction, the famous Mendenhall Glacier.

Your journey begins with a narrated tour of Juneau's downtown waterfront en route to the Mendenhall Glacier Recreation Area. Upon arrival at the glacier, your guide points out areas of interest so you may make the most of your one-and-a-half-hour stay.

Marvel at the beautiful Mendenhall, one of 38 glaciers flowing from the massive 1,500-square-mile Juneau Ice field. The ample visiting time allows for an unhurried exploration of this glacial wonder from a variety of perspectives.

Day 4: Skagway, Alaska Arrive 6AM Depart 8:15PM

Few one-time boomtowns retain the flavor of the gold rush days like Skagway. This gateway to the Klondike is preserved as a national historic park with its rustic boardwalk and frontier-style storefronts. Due to its geographic location, Skagway enjoys a drier climate compared to the rest of southeastern Alaska, with an average annual precipitation of only 22 inches.

One of the many Optional Excursions that will be offered on this Cruise:

White Pass Scenic Railway

Take an unforgettable journey aboard the "Scenic Railway of the World" to the White Pass summit.

Fully narrated, the White Pass & Yukon Route is unlike any other railroad. Against all odds, the

iron trail was carved through some of the North's most rugged terrain in 1898. This engineering wonder climbs nearly 3,000 feet over 20 miles of steep grades and cliff-hanging turns. Relax in vintage railcars as your train agent retraces the original route to the White Pass summit, passing Bridal Veil Falls, Inspiration Point and Dead Horse Gulch. Enjoy a breathtaking panorama of mountains, glaciers, gorges, waterfalls, tunnels, trestles and historic sites. See the original Klondike Trail of '98 worn into the rocks, a permanent tribute to the thousands of souls who passed this way in search of fortune. Board the train right at the cruise ship pier.

Day 5: Tracy Arm Fjord, Alaska (Scenic Cruising) Arrive 8:00AM Depart 1:00PM

Day 6: Ketchikan, Alaska Arrive 6:00AM Depart 12:30PM

This southern-most Alaskan port city is known as Alaska's First City because it was the first major community travelers came to heading north. Founded as a fishing camp, Ketchikan is built on steep hillsides and is billed as the salmon capital of the world. A quaint village, the town is just three miles long and three blocks wide.

Totem Traditions

See all the sights of Ketchikan, including enchanting Totem Bight State Park.

Board your motor coach for a 25-mile drive in and around Ketchikan. See Alaska's busiest waterfront, bustling with floatplanes and boats, and drive by infamous Creek Street, Ketchikan's former red-light district. Travel along scenic North Tongass Highway, passing salmon canneries and a pulp mill that was once the largest of its kind in the world.

Then your guide introduces you to Totem Bight State Park, where an awesome sight awaits. After walking along a winding trail through a forest of mighty hemlock, you come to an old Indian campsite filled with colorful totem poles each representing a fascinating tale. Learn about Native Alaskan culture at the park's Ceremonial House. Enjoy a cookie at the Alaska Totem Trading Company before your return to town.

Day 7: Victoria, British Columbia Arrive 7:00PM Depart 11:59PM

Once a British colonial post, Victoria is full of historic sites, public parks and groomed gardens. Due to its location, this quaint yet sophisticated little seaside city boasts the mildest climate in Canada.

Victoria by Horse-Drawn Trolley

Experience the beauty of Victoria by horse-drawn trolley and take a trip back in time. Your fully narrated journey begins at the cruise ship terminal and winds its way through historic James Bay and the Inner Harbor. Enjoy the old world architecture of the Legislative Buildings -

illuminated by thousands of tiny lights during late evening tours - and the historic Empress Hotel. Then travel through Beacon Hill Park, the natural heart of Victoria. The 154 acres of carefully preserved trees, gardens and wildflower meadows provide a peaceful haven amidst a bustling community.
