

## 8 Day Pilgrimage to Prague

visiting Prague, Kunta Hora, Sedlec, Cesky Krumlov

October 15 – 22, 2007

Mon, Oct 15th: Depart JFK on your overnight flight to Prague. Dinner served in flight.

Tue. Oct 16th: Prague

Morning arrival in **Prague** and transfer to your hotel in the city center. Free day to relax. This evening we have a **Welcome Folklore Dinner**. (B,D)

Wed, Oct 17th: Prague city tour

This morning we have a walking tour of the city. This is a full day tour. You will visit Prague Castle including St. Vitus Cathedral and other notable places in the surrounding area as well as the Golden Lane with lots of picturesque little shops. Then you walk down the Chateau steps to the Lesser town to see St. Nicholas Church and visit the Church of Our Lady of Victory to see the Miraculous Child Jesus – the Infant of Prague. Break for lunch (on your own) after which we cross Charles Bridge and walk the narrow lanes of the Old City to the square with its unique Astronomical Clock. This evening we have a **Vltava River Cruise with Dinner**. (B,D)

Thu, Oct 18th: Trip to Karlstejn Castle

Today we visit the majestic, Karlstein Castle. The gothic castle was built 650 years ago on a picturesque site in the middle of a dense forest. The royal castle was built by the emperor Charles IV as a fortification for the storage of the crown jewels. In the past, entry to this castle was strictly forbidden to women. Afternoon return to Prague. (B,D)

Fri, Oct 19th: Kutna Hora and Sedlec ossuary

Morning tour of **Kutna Hora**. This famous medieval town is listed as a UNESCO heritage site. It is well known for its old silver mines. You will visit the unique ossuary in **Sedlec**, see the Cisterciacs Monastery, visit the Italian Court and the amazing Cathedral of St. Barbara (a baroque pearl). Afternoon return to Prague. (B,D)

Sat, Oct 20th: Cesky Krumlov

**Cesky Krumlov** is 2<sup>nd</sup> (just behind Venice) on the UNESCO list of the world's most remarkable towns. The town and castle were established in the first half of the 13<sup>th</sup> c. and the town houses are a unique collection of gothic, renaissance and baroque buildings. A natural theatrical stage with a unique rotating auditorium is situated in the park above the castle. (B,D)

Sun, Oct 21st: Prague

Free day to enjoy your last day in Prague. This evening **Farewell Folklore Dinner**. (B,D)

Mon, Oct 22nd: Prague/USA

After breakfast we depart to the airport for your return flight to the USA. (B)
